Find a warm welcome in All Souls Church on Overbury Street, the Pedro Youth Centre on Rushmore Road or the After School Club on Pedro Street.

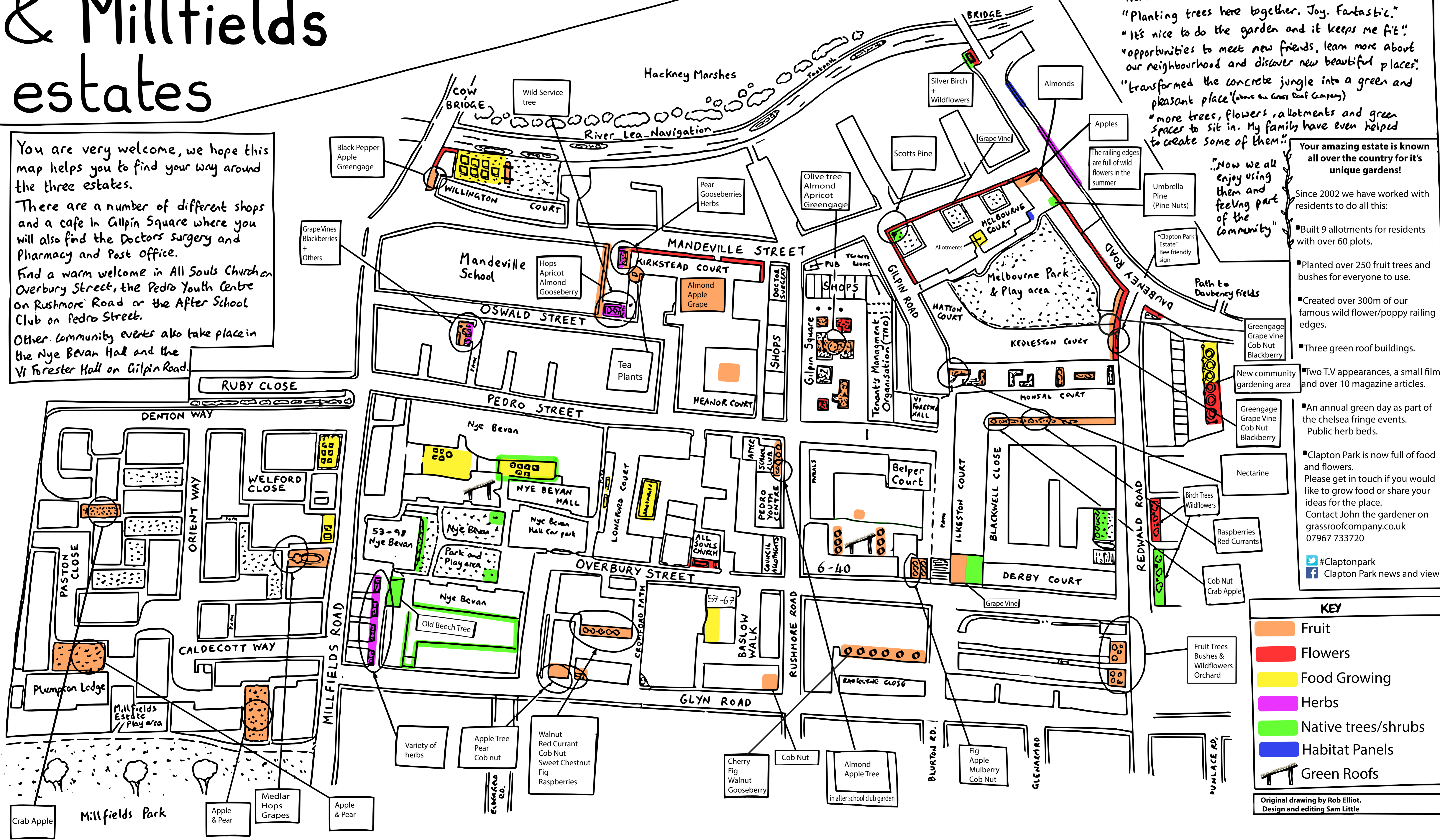
Other community events also take place in the Nye Bevan Hall and the Vi Forester Hall on Gilpin Road.

- An annual green day as part of the Chelsea fringe events. Public herb beds.
